Documented Crimes :

- Hostage-taking of remains, demanding “bullet money” from grieving families and intimidating survivors

The Duty of the Free World to Secure Global Peace

Immediate Actions Required

- Designate the IRGC (Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps) as a terrorist organization
- Expel the regime’s ambassadors and shut down their embassies
- Recognize Prince Reza Pahlavi as the legitimate representative of the Iranian people’s call for a peaceful transition to a secular, democratic system
- Remove the regime from international organizations
- Formally recognize its actions as crimes against humanity, including mass killings and executions
- Guarantee humanitarian support and uninterrupted internet access during the next nationwide uprising
